Dear Saints in Christ,

Luther penned the words to *Ein Feste Burg* sometime between 1527 and 1530, on this, scholars debate. If your German is like mine and is *Nein* that would be the hymn *A Mighty Fortress*. That is the appointed hymn of the day for Lent 1, which is this Sunday. Luther wrote *A Mighty Fortress* as an exposition of Psalm 46. More specifically he wrote it to apply it to the his own life and the life of a Christian. How beautiful a hymn, but how much more beautiful a Psalm.

It is about fully trusting in the Lord. Which is something that none of us are good at doing. We like to trust Him a little bit, or maybe a bit more, but never the whole way. We want to leave part of it up to ourselves. We don't like anyone else having control. Just turn on the news or read the headlines. Autonomy is king. We are Lord's over ourselves. Society cries out with Nietzsche that "God is Dead."

But we know the exact opposite to be true. God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. Dear people loved by God, your Lord is with you always. In the midst of the muck and mire of life, He is here. Cast your anxieties on Him.

The world may crumble around us, things may not shine as brightly as they used too, but the Lord is still good. We have nothing to fear. For the Father sent His Beloved Son, in whom he is well pleased, so that He might suffer and die. We need not fear the unknown, for Christ has conquered death and the grave is but a portal to life eternal.

"Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!" This world is full of death and decay; full of temptations and enticements; of doubt and distrust. In the midst of all of this though, your Lord is beside you "upon the plain with His good gifts and Spirit. So no matter the attacks hurled at you by Satan and his legion, you can tell them to back from whence they came. They have been shut up, shackled, and silenced for you. They have been defeated. One little word can fell them, for the victory has been won and the kingdom yours remaineth.


